## Meals: It's healthy and tastes good

People who move a lot need to eat good food. A fresh, varied and tasty lunch is prepared daily in our own kitchen. In the morning, we offer a full breakfast and in the afternoon, another eating break, e.g. with fruit and vegetable sticks. Children who stay until 5:00 pm get a "late shift snack". For our little ones, as well as for allergy sufferers, diabetics and others, we offer special types of food. Our meals have been awarded the Fit-Kid Seal of the German Society for Nutrition.

# Preschool: The gap year

The best way to learn is in familiar surroundings, alongside friends and trusted educators. Our day-care's preschool offers our 5 to 6-year-olds playful experiences with numbers and letters, exciting projects (e.g. "What can fly?"), as well as trips out to nature, to museums, etc. Prepared to this extent, our little researchers and discoverers will have a successful start into the 1st grade.

# Day nursery: A place for feeling secure

When a child comes to our day-care centre, they are usually in the day nursery age. In order for them to take in the new environment and build a bond with our educators, they get a gentle four-week familiarization with loving, dependable caregivers. Everything takes place following the personal rhythm of the child and in close exchange with the parents. This establishes so much trust that they are open to friendships, education and advancement and experience the day in a spirit of discovery.

# Integration: We stick together

Every child is different, and some need extra support. In our integration groups, special education and pedagogical experts work with additional special needs education. Further support in day-care and in individual situations is provided by physiotherapeutic, speech and occupational therapists. Plus: children have barrier-free access via ramps and a lift.
